A Regular Member is entitled to notice of and to attend, participate and vote at meetings of the Members, to be a director or officer of the Corporation and to serve on committees of the Corporation.</p>
	<p>An Associate Member is a non-nursing health care professional who supports the mission and vision of CANO/ACIO. An Associate Member is entitled to notice of and to attend and participate at meetings of the Members but is not entitled to vote at such meetings, nor may she be a director or officer of the Corporation or serve on a committee of the Corporation.</p>
	<p>An Affiliate Member is an organization, government agency, or supplier of goods and services related to oncology nursing. An Affiliate Member is entitled to notice of and to attend meetings of the Members but is not entitled to participate or vote at such meetings, nor may she be a director or officer of the Corporation or serve on a committee of the Corporation.</p>
	<p>A Student Member is a full time student studying to become a Registered Nurse or a Registered Practical Nurse/Licensed Practical Nurse or who has returned to study in an academic program, irrespective of the level of nursing education being pursued. A Student Member is entitled to notice of and to attend and participate at meetings of the Members and serve on a committee, but is not entitled to vote at such meetings, nor may she be a director or officer of the Corporation.</p>
	<p>A Non-working Member is a Nurse who has retired or is receiving long-term disability benefits. A Non-working Member is entitled to notice of and to attend and participate at meetings of the Members but is not entitled to vote at such meetings, nor may she be a director or officer of the Corporation or serve on a committee of the Corporation.</p>

	<p>Certification in Oncology Nursing. Opportunity to participate in study groups at the local chapter level to prepare you to become a Canadian certified oncology nurse through the Canadian Nurses Association.</p>
