Nurse Practitioner PRCC Radiation Oncology Permanent Full Time

We are looking for an Oncology Nurse Practitioner for an exciting new role designed to enhance the care of patients undergoing multimodal therapy, for thoracic or pelvic malignancies. Through the provision of advanced nursing practice, this individual will work as an independent practitioner and in collaboration with an interprofessional team.

Qualifications:

- Graduate of a recognized college or school of nursing
- Current Certificate of Competence from the College of Nurses of Ontario
- Masters Degree in Nursing or an approved nurse practitioner component
- RN(EC)
- Membership with CANO/ACIO, Cancer Care Ontario of practice for advance practice nurses, RNAO and NPAO required
- Minimum of three years oncology nursing experience, preferably in radiation therapy
- Exceptional skills of leadership, self-direction, interpersonal communication and ability to work in an interdisciplinary team

Responsibilities:

- Practice his/her full legislated and regulated scope of practice.
- Work collaboratively with nurses, radiation oncologists and interprofessional team.
- Promote new ideas and innovations, in collaboration with the interprofessional team, to expedite and improve the efficiencies in the flow of radiation patients.
- Perform a comprehensive medical/nursing history and physical and psychosocial assessment of the patient's health status.
- Liaise with regional partners in order to ensure best possible care.
- Initiate a NP LED Clinic for patients experiencing symptom distress.
- Contribute to quality initiatives, identifying, implementing and evaluating best practices and leadership activities within the radiation program and the cancer centre.
- Work in review clinics with Radiation Oncologist and Primary RN for patients receiving RADs as part of multimodal therapy for thoracic and pelvic cancers.
- Develop and document a plan of care for patients, including appropriate follow-up in the community, in collaboration with the interdisciplinary team members.
- Order and interpret diagnostic and laboratory tests based on defined medical directives.
- In collaboration with the physician and/or pharmacist, prescribe pharmacological agents and therapeutic measures within practice guidelines (as defined by scope of practice and medical directives).
